Dear Sir:

Your attention is invited to the provision of Para 6, of negotiated agreement No. W-04-193-ENG-3964, dated 4 March 1944, which provides that the United States of America lease certain properties from Brigham City Corporation.

The above cited reference states that "the lessor shall furnish to the Government, as part of the rental consideration, the following: Sufficient water for normal needs of the camp."

Your attention is also further invited to the provisions of free rental agreement entered into on the 27th day of February 1940, between the Office of the Quartermaster General and Brigham City Corporation, which provides, in part, "sufficient water needed in conducting said camp."

It is requested, at this time, that Brigham City Corporation make a refund, payable to the Treasury of the United States, for the amounts paid Brigham City Corporation for water at Bear River CCC Camp. In this connection, the following is quoted from a first indorsement dated 9 March 1945, from the Office of the Division Engineer, Salt Lake Sub-office: "If the Post has inadvertently made payments to the City for water furnished to the Bear River Camp, the City should be requested to refund the money and furnish water, according to the terms of the lease."

Attached hereto is a listing of the water bills for Bear River Camp presented by Brigham City Corporation and paid by the United States Government. These records indicate that \$275.63 is due in connection with this refund.

Your kind attention to this matter will be appreciated.
