THANKSGIVING AT BUSHNELL GENERAL HOSPITAL

Thanksgiving is the day traditionally given to reminiscing and remembrance of great events during the past year and years for which we can in our small way give thanks.

At this season many of our thoughts run back across the events that have transpired here at Bushnell General Hospital since its inception. During the spring of 1942 the need for greatly expanded hospital facilities for army use became apparent and the medical department began building a number of large modern hospitals. Among these new hospitals was one to be situated at Brigham City, Utah. At the time of its construction it had not been designated by name and was simply known as U. S. Army General Hospital, Brigham City, Utah. The site selected was one at the south end of Brigham City, covered by orchards and small farms. In April of 1942 the contractors began clearing the area necessary for construction, leaving as much as possible of the orchards and family type structures. Huge excavations were begun and forms were laid for concrete foundations, and brick walls began to rise at an amazing rate. Area engineer and army representative, Capt. A. W. Flandro of the engineers supervised the specifications and construction of this great project.

Early in April, Colonel Robert M. Hardaway, MC, arrived to assume command of the new hospital and plan for its operation. Some buildings were turned over to the army as early as August, and by October the hospital was ready to receive patients. The first nine patients arrived October 10, 1942 by transfer from the station hospital at Fort Douglas. In the meantime a staff of hand-picked specialists from all over the United States had been assembled and the ground work laid for the reception of patients and the future operation of the hospital. After opening of Bushnell, the staff was rapidly augmented and patients began to arrive by large hospital train convoys, some of these convoys bringing in as many as 300 patients at once. The careful planning of previous months became apparent at such times when large groups of patients were received, initially examined and comfortably settled in their respective wards.

Throughout early 1943 the patient strength continued to rise rapidly, and a maximum strength of several thousand patients was soon reached. At this time the hospital was designated as a center for many types of specialized treatment and the special study of the wonder drug penicillin and also for advanced clinical research of malaria. The reconditioning program was begun early with a view toward returning as many men as possible to the ranks and toward rehabilitating those who necessarily had to return to civilian life. By now the hospital has been fairly settled into its routine and into fulfilling its inspirational purpose.

Remembering the outstanding beginning of this institution, in viewing its highly successful present operations, one can only look toward a brilliant and outstanding future for Bushnell General Hospital and the many patients who will pass through its gates.

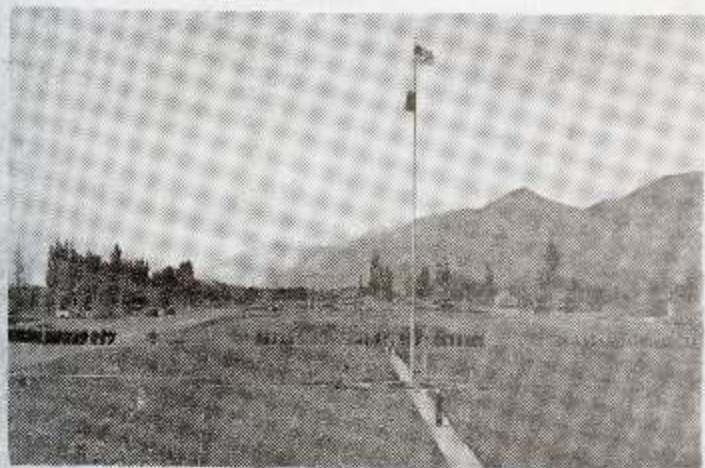

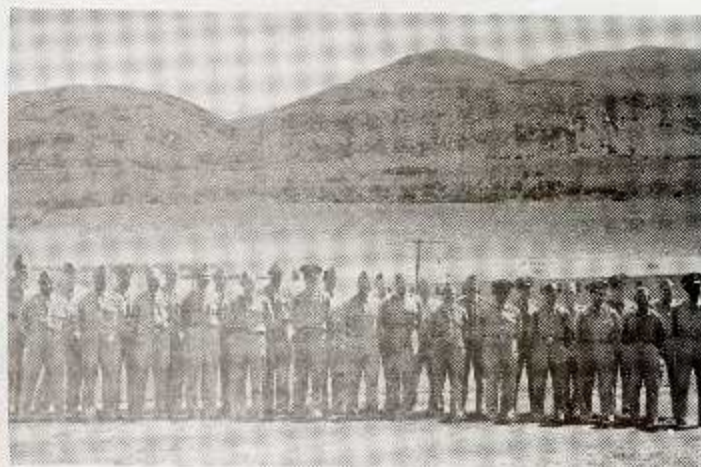

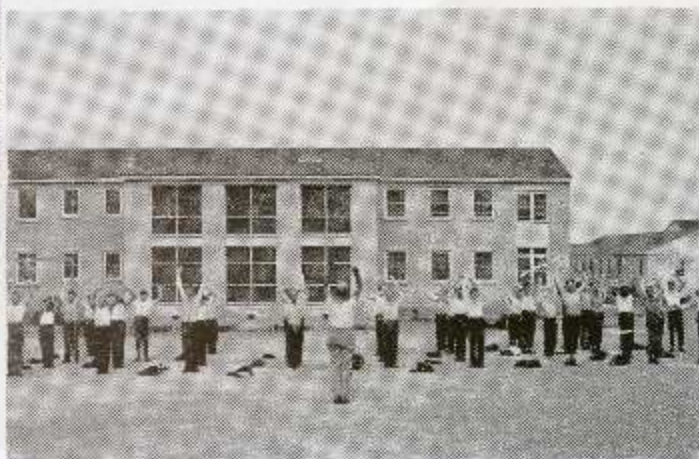
